- Design and turnkey installation of a 25MW Microgrid to serve 100% of the Standby Power needs for the Marine Corp Air Station in Yuma AZ
- Provides Arizona Public Service (APS) with Autonomous Frequency Control and Peak Load Management
- PowerSecure provides 24/7 Monitoring and all Preventive Maintenance on the Microgrid
- This project was Phase 1 of a planned Microgrid that will also include Solar PV and Battery Storage in the future.
